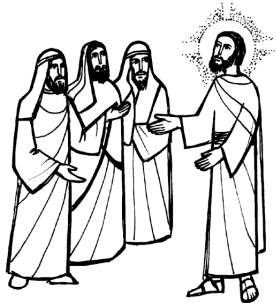
Diocesan Prayer Link - we pray for the parish of Wellington
